

White Wines

Coastal Sauvignon Blanc France

A vibrant, dry white wine with fresh grassy characteristics and notes of tropical fruit. Coastal Reserve is working in partnership with Plastic Oceans Europe - an international charity dedicated to ending plastic pollution within all marine and freshwater sources throughout the continent. (pb)

Honu Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand
A fantastic example of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc - this delicious white wine is crisp on the palate with notes of orange and lemon peel.

Castello Di Gabbiano Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Italy With a medium body this beautiful Italian white offers a balanced profile of fresh citrus fruits, green apple and pear tied together with a pleasantly soft acidity.

Los Gansos Viognier Valle Central, Chile

Los Gansos is named in homage to the geese that roam freely on the vineyard, removing pests that would otherwise harm the vines- eliminating the need for pesticides. This lively wine boasts a medium-dry profile with notes of peach, apricot and subtle citrus. Fresh and lively.

Freixenet Pinot Grigio Garda, Italy - £30

This crisp Pinot Grigio from northern Italy, combines delicate floral aromas with subtle elements of fresh apple, fresh lemon and honey on the palate.

La Font Francaise, Picpoul de Pinet, France - £25

Hailing from the Cave Ormarine winery, this beautiful Picpoul boasts a delicious minerality from the limestone-clay terroir of the region.

Langlois-Chateau Sancerre, Loire Valley, France - £44

A classic from the heart of the historic Loire valley. Aromas of slate and grapefruit peel introduce a complex mix of citrus, tree fruit and gooseberry on the tongue.

Brunner Piespotter Mosel, Germany - £24

A lovely, off-dry option with fresh but soft notes of fleshy peach, fresh pear and honey reinforced with balanced acidity.



White Wines

La Lancellotta Gavi Piemonte, Italy - £28

A zesty wine with floral characteristics pushing through melon, pear and stone fruit front notes followed by an underlying minerality balanced with a touch of fresh fennel. (pb)

Columbia Chardonnay Washington DC, USA - £32

A full bodied, lightly aged chardonnay that is packed with buttery brioche notes supported by hints of cooking apple and grapefruit.

Vionta Albarino Rias Baixas, Spain - £38

This playful new-world wine from the north-west area of the region has been bottled early to preserve the fresh tree fruit flavours, with a bracing acidity that cascades across the palate - accentuating notes of peach, pear and apple-blossom.

Olivier Tricon Chablis Burgundy, France - £50

Bright, elegant crisp minerality and refreshing citrus-like acidity. Beautifully balanced, this is benchmark Chablis. This vineyard gets its flinty minerality from the Jurassic soils it is situated on.

Domaine Des Maillettes Grand Reserve Pouilly Fuissé, France - £65

Among the top rated wines in the world, the Pouilly Fuissé is a rich Burgundian white with notes of apple and pear, accented with vanilla and leaves a buttery biscuit finish on the palate.

A truly elegant wine with an abundance of character.

Rose Wines

Coastal Pinot Grigio Rosato Pavia Italy

Produced in the province of Pavia, where the long, slow ripening season helps create wines of quality and finesse. Juicy honeysuckle and galia melon give way to a clean red berry finish. (pb)

Winston Hill White Zinfandel California, USA

A major crowd pleaser from the sunshine state. Luscious strawberry ice cream on the nose gives way to bright redcurrants and red fruits on the palate with an off-dry finish. Deliciously juicy.

Freixenet Italian Rose Garda, Italy - £30

This charming rose is made from the typical grape varieties of Veneto-Corvina and Garganega. It's refreshing with a subtle perfume and delicate palate of sweet cherries and strawberries.

AIX Rose Provence France - £45/£85

AIX is the epitome of sophistication and quality. The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicately youthful, and offers notes of watermelon, wild strawberries and subtle floral notes.



Red Wines

Coastal Reserve Merlot Spain

The long Spanish summers help to ripen these grapes, concentrating the rich plumb and black fruit flavours whilst maintaining a rich structure and warm vanilla spice.

Los Gansos Pinot Noir Valle Central, Chile

Los Gansos is named in homage to the geese who roam freely in the vineyard, eating the pests which would otherwise harm the vines and eliminating the need for pesticides. Intensely fruity on the nose with bramble and cassis. A light bodied red on the palate, silky and elegant on the finish.

Flagstone Longitude Western Cape, South Africa - £24

A complex blend of shiraz, cabernet sauvignon, petit verdot, grenache, mourvèdre and pinot noir. The nose shows plums and dark berries, with spicy undertones and hints of crushed cashew nuts and fresh mint. The palate is all about silky tannins and length, bright flavours of plum and berries combined with the subtle tannins, makes this smooth on the finish.

Les Caprices Cotes du Rhone Rhone Valley, France - £28

Fabulously jammy black fruit flavours make up the backbone of this fabulous wine's profile with hints of white pepper and cinnamon. A classic of the southern Rhone with extra grenache added to the blend, coming together in an irresistibly accessible wine.

Solar Viejo Crianza Rioja, Spain

A blend of tempranillo and gratiano grapes are fermented and pressed before being aged for 12 months in French and American oak casks followed by a long period of bottle ageing. This wine delivers cassis and violet aromas accented by chocolate and coffee. The palate follows the nose and has a good structure and velvety texture.

Punta De Flechas Malbec, Uco Valley, Argentina

A full bodied red with concentrated blackberries, ripe plums and tobacco leaf notes and a long complex finish.

Red Wines

J Bouchon Pais Salvaje Tinto Valle Central Chile - £34

A versatile red with notes of raspberry and plum on the nose with luscious flavours of strawberry jam, tobacco and pickled plum. Pais Salvaje is 100% naturally-vinified using century-old winemaking techniques, including the use of the zaranda (a structure made of sticks to destem the grape clusters).

Solar Viejo Reserve, Rioja, Spain - £39

A blend of tempranillo and gratiano grapes aged for 12 months in French and American oak barrels followed by extensive bottle ageing. Coffee, chocolate and violet and blackcurrant on the nose, which the palate follows with a hint of black pepper. Robust structure and velvety texture.

Ciacci Piccolomini Ateo Tuscany, Italy - £44

Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona Sant'Antimo Ateo has an intense bouquet with vibrant herbal, spicy and fruit-forward notes. Very well structured, full bodied, quite soft and balanced with pronounced tannins. A wine with a great personality and long aftertaste. Ateo or "the Atheist" gets its name from the people of Tuscany, who believe their wine is of such high quality that it was from God.

Torre Del Falasco Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy - £40

Aromas of dried cherry and dark plums are followed by hints of mocha and dark chocolate on the nose. A powerful, full bodied wine on the palate opens with spiced fruit character and supportive tannins. Raisins and candied orange peel notes come from the "ripasso" method. This wine has a long finish with added notes of nutmeg.

Q Clay Syrah-Cabernet Sauvignon Colchagua, Chile - £48

Complex aromas of ripe red berries and cherry liqueur. The palate is soft, full bodied and rich with sweet tannins. Notes of blueberry jam and spice, with layers of mocha and chocolate to finish.

Penfolds Bin 2 Shiraz-Mataro South Australia - £56

Penfolds' Bin 2 was first released in 960 – but was temporarily discontinued in the 1970s during the country's white wine boom. Now it's back, made under the watchful eye of Chief Winemaker Peter Gago. It's a blend of Shiraz and Mataro – also known as Mourvèdre. A gentle creaminess washes the palate in fresh white fig and plum with subtle vanilla and licorice from the 9 month ageing process in French white oak barrels.
